Ditak Village School: background



- School was built in 1967 and never renovated since then.
- This is a secondary community school, which provides education to nearly 90 pupils aged from 6 to 17 years.
- The school has 17 teachers who are mainly women with exception of 3 men.
- They were doing their bests to provide a possibly good education to children in very difficult conditions: lack of normal heating, poor sanitation, broken windows and floors, unhealthy state of building substance.


